Post 586 Thanksgiving Gift Cards Giveaway

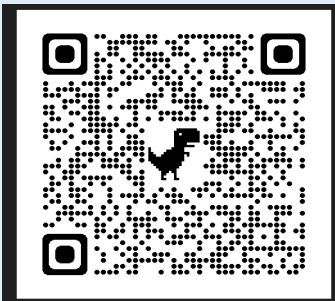


This year is our Second Annual Thanksgiving Gift Card Giveaway. We are planning to giveaway 50 \$25 gift cards to troops and veterans that are in need.

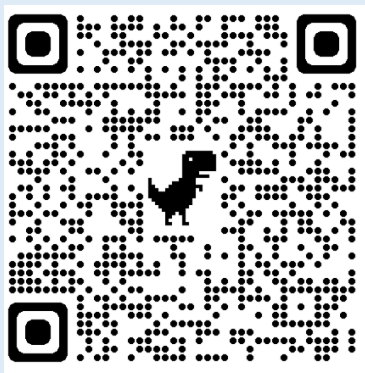

What is Daylight Savings Time (DST)? DST is the practice of advancing clocks one hour during warmer months so that darkness falls at a later time. Which allows for saving energy and making better use of daylight. DST is implemented by setting clocks forward by one hour in the spring (spring forward), and setting clocks back by one hour in autumn (fall back). As a result, there is one 23-hour day in late winter and one 25-hour day in autumn.
